

DO's and DONT's of what to WEAR and BRING:



Options for shirt/top - one being an SUU shirt

Option for jacket/coat - dependent upon weather

Pants or slacks - see note about shorts/skirts

Shoes - dependent upon location and activity

DO's:

- Solid colors preferred.
- Pastels and jewel tones good, but not vivid, "glowing" color, e.g. neon.
- Clothing that is free of holes, stains, rips or piling.
- Always bring an additional shirt with SUU lettering.

DONT's:

- No solid blacks (grays, browns and navy are good alternatives for dark colors).
- No whites (off-white, cream, beige, soft yellow or light blue are good alternatives).
- Avoid bright green.
- No small stripes or patterns (e.g. checks or houndstooth). Large plaid is okay.
- No logos or written words (unless SUU related), NO other college clothing.
- Avoid large, shiny jewelry or watches.
- Extremely casual, oversized t-shirts that are longer than shorts.
- Graphic Tess with language, images, or logos of bands or political movements that don't align with our values.
- Athleisure (workout clothes).
- Wearing undergarments on top of shirt.
- Crop tops.

NOTES:

- Be mindful of your undergarments:
 - **Women:** bras that are skin-toned with no lace or decoration or seams are best. Fitted tank tops or shaping underwear (like Spanx) are helpful.
 - **Men:** undershirts or tanktops under dress shirts. Wear underwear that does not bunch or show above the waistline.
- Bring a comb and additional hair products for touchups. Women, bring personal makeup.
- Bring a bag to hold your wallet, cell phone or car keys. You don't want anything in your pockets that bulge during the shoot.
- Shorts and skirts are okay if they are at an appropriate length (fingertip rule) and don't take away from the shoot's atmosphere (e.g. professional video with professors/president).
- Avoid trendy clothing that will look outdated quickly.
